## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

### JOHNNY WOOLBRIGHT SPEED DRILL CAMP, INC.

I, the undersigned, for the purpose of becoming incorporated as a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, and I do hereby subscribe to and adopt the following as articles of incorporation:

#### ARTICLE 1. - NAME

The name of this corporation is JOHNNY WOOLBRIGHT SPEED DRILL CAMP, INC.

#### ARTICLE 2. - PURPOSES

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The corporation shall endeavor to run a speed drill camp, and any other business which the members feel would assist the corporation in achieving it's goals.

#### ARTICLE 3. - LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth elsewhere herein. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE 4. - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

## **ARTICLE 5. -- QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS**

The membership of this corporation shall consist of those persons hereinafter named as subscribers and such other persons as, from time to time, shall become members in the manner provided by the Bylaws.

## **ARTICLE 6. -- TERM OF EXISTENCE**

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

## **ARTICLE 7. -- SUBSCRIBERS**

The names and residences of the subscribers to these articles are:

## **ARTICLE 8. -- OFFICERS**

Section 1. The officers of the corporation shall be a president, a vice-president, a secretary and a treasurer, and such other officers as may be provided in the Bylaws.

Section 2. No person may hold more than one office except that the Bylaws may provide that the offices of secretary and treasurer may be combined.

## **ARTICLE 9. -- BOARD OF DIRECTOR**

Section 1. The business affairs of this corporation shall have three directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time but shall never be less than three.

Section 2. The Directors shall be members of the corporation.

Section 3. Members of the Board of Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the membership.

Section 4. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first election thereof are as follows:

#### **ARTICLE 10. -- BYLAWS**

Bylaws of this corporation shall be made and may be altered or rescinded by majority vote of those members present at any regular meeting or at any special meeting called for that purpose. Notice of any special meeting shall be given as provided in the Bylaws.

#### **ARTICLE 11. -- AMENDMENTS**

Section 1. These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any annual meeting of the membership or at any special meeting of the membership called for that purpose, by a two-thirds vote of those present.

Section 2. Amendments may also be made by the Board of Directors at any meeting of the Board, provided at least ten days' notice of such proposed amendment or amendments be given to all members of the corporation by regular U.S. Mail.

#### **ARTICLE 12. -- PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

The location of the principal office of this corporation shall be 3235 NW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Cape Coral, Florida 33993, but may, from time to time, be changed to any other location in the State of Florida. Meetings of the Board of Directors and meetings of the membership may be held at any place within or outside the State of Florida, provided notice shall be given as provided by the Bylaws.

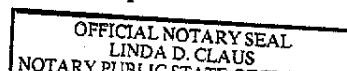
