ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

TF Creations Corp.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be TF Creations Corp.: The principal place of business of this corporation shall be 354 Brazilian Avenue, #5, Palm Beach, FL 33480.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

ARTICLE V. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE VI. DIRECTORS

ARTICLE XI. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Any related party contract or transaction must be authorized, approved or ratified at a meeting of the Board of Directors by sufficient vote thereon by directors not interested therein or the transaction must be fair and reasonable to the Corporation.

ARTICLE XII. INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify its Officers, Directors, Employees and Agents in accordance with the following:.
