I submitted the original document on time and with the proper payment, but it appears I forgot to sign it.



My family was hit with a critical medical problem that has disrupted the entire family and our work. Previously, my wife had handled all of the paper work for our corporation. However, my wife suffered a significant medical problem and everything here came to a complete stop for the last few months. We did receive your letter telling us I had not signed the document, but our mail just stacked up without being read. Otherwise, we would have answered your letter promptly.
