We received your correspondence of October 23, 2003. There appears to be some confusion interpreting our first letter to you. I thought my second letter would clear up any confusion, but apparently, it did not. However, the fee to reinstate our Corporation continues to rise even while we correspond back and forth.

I did not receive the first renewal. I only became aware of this after receiving the second notice of renewal, but that also required a \$550 amount due.

The initial response was dictated by our accountant in an attempt to assist us.

We have responded to each renewal with our request to abate the penalties and increased charges. We have requested that we be allowed to reinstate our Corporation for the original amount of \$150.00. We receive a response each time for a higher amount! The filing amount is now up to a total of \$750.00. We are a small corporation doing a small local business. To pay fees of this amount would create a hardship on us in such a dismal economy. We have been on time every year since our inception in 1990.


Please accept our apologies and allow us to pay the original amount due of \$150.00. We promise to put the date on our on our calendar in case we don't receive the renewal papers again.
