The failure of this corporation to file an annual report by May 1st was an unintentional mistake. As vice president and office manager of Silver Oaks I have not yet neglected a duty of this significance so I can only assume that the mailing did not reach my office. Since our business was closed from February to May due to El Nino flooding, much of our mail was detoured to homes on the driveable side of the floodwater. I believe the original packet may have been part of this mail. Although we did not apply for financial aid, we were issued a U. S. SBA loan disaster application form (3040/9695) from Atlanta on January 8, 1998.

We would appreciate the State considering waivering the penalty for this unintentional error.
