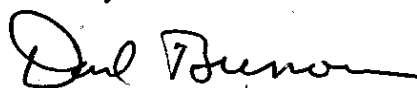
Last week I called the Division of Corporations regarding the filing of the annual UBR. I do not remember receiving our notice regarding the UBR and am asking for a waiver of the late filing fee (for last year).
