Dear Kathy Ashton:

We are returning the signed document, along with the check and requesting for you to please waive the reinstatement fee. We did return the corrected document last year along with a handwritten explanation and a copy of the cancelled check (enclosed). This was done on April 30, 2002. We then received another notice and at that time called your office and we were told to write an explanation and ask for the late fee to be waived. Again we mailed a letter (was not dated) in which we explained what happened and requested that the late payments be cancelled (enclosed).

On January 30, 2003 we received a letter from Sean Toner in your office requesting us to correct the UBR with the new registered agents signature. In the letter it states that once this was done the report would be filed without the penalty. It went on to say that an additional \$150 was due for the 2003 return, which is the one being returned to us now. From the January 30<sup>th</sup> 2003 letter it appeared to us that all we needed to do was sign the document and return it along with the \$150 fee. Now we get a notice asking us to explain what happened and to request a waiver. Well, that is what we tried to do here. We hope this is sufficient and solves the problem.
