

## "DECORATIVE" CONTINUED FROM PG. 15

There is a delicious small gilt-bronze lamp attributed to Larché, a French Art Nouveau craftsman, of the dancer Loïe Fuller, that won a gold medal at the French Exposition Universalle in Paris in 1900. This lamp was extraordinary in its time in that it was fitted with one of the scientific wonders of the age; an electric light bulb. Loïe Fuller, the American dancer who was a huge hit at the Folies Bergère, was not only famous for romantic veil-twirling performances that made her resemble a fluttering moth or butterfly, but also because her dances were captured on one of Europe's earliest experimental short films by the Lumière brothers. These can be seen on Google.

Each artifact in this installation is a fine example of what it purports to be, and this is surely what this gallery is all about: a quiet place in which to contemplate objects of extraordinary quality and outstanding craftsmanship and design. Although paintings are classified as Fine Arts, the few on display were included in this new installation to emphasize selected themes of the decorative arts through color and subject matter. Many of the art objects were made to be used; the paintings originally hung in homes made more beautiful by their very presence. The fine condition of all these lovely artifacts attests to recognition of their specialness and the care with which they were indeed used and looked after. •
