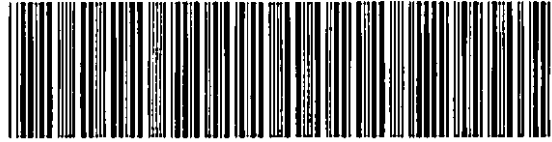





Wright's ethos is that everyone is better off because of WMG's involvement. Wright's core values and striving to exceptional excellence are fundamental to Wright Maritime's success.
