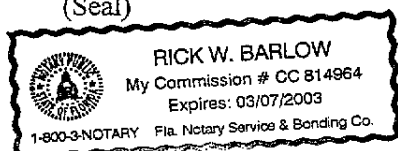

MEG Announces PhosPhilter™ Technology by Larry D. Madrid

In the ever-increasing fight to clean up surface water before it reaches our streams, rivers, and lakes, new technologies are being sought to reduce pollutants, especially nutrients that can disrupt the natural balance in these waters. Madrid Engineering Group Inc. has developed a solution that may be the most cost effective yet in this battle. It's called PhosPhilter™.

PhosPhilter™ is the engineered system that uses iron humate, a patented co-product of the water treatment industry, to filter the surface water and retain up to 90 percent of the phosphorus, both particulate and dissolved. Its high cation exchange capacity enables it to retain phosphorus, on a mole per mole basis. Iron humate is a combination of organic humus (60 to 70 percent) and iron (20 to 30 percent), and resembles an iron-rich peaty soil. Iron humate has been tested extensively for FDEP compliance and been found to be extremely environmentally friendly.

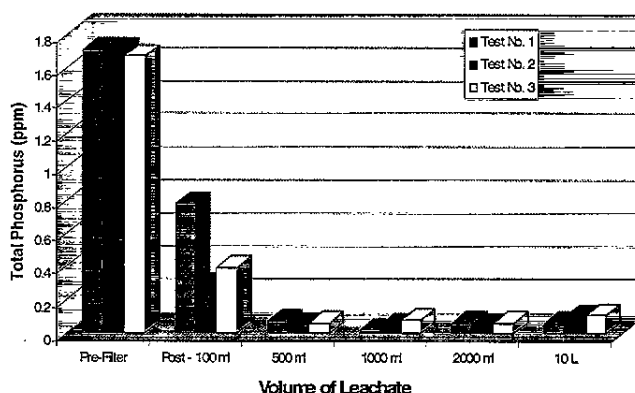
Recent federal regulations for non-point source pollution, such as agricultural runoff and urban stormwater are known as the TMDL – Total Maximum Daily Load. The Florida Watershed Restoration Act (1999) specifically addresses the need to improve water quality basin-wide, and provides the regulatory framework to protect this vital resource that includes over 50,000 miles of rivers and streams, and over 7,800 lakes.

Existing technologies include STA's – stormwater treatment areas that are essentially huge created wetlands that can reduce the phosphorus load by up to 80 percent. Even so, further reduction is needed to meet the requirement of 10 ppm for inflows to Lake Okeechobee, for example.

Madrid has completed studies that indicate up to 90 percent reduction in total

phosphorus in surface water runoff using a new filtration media, PhosPhilter™. It can be deployed in ditches, pipes, swales, retention ponds and wetlands. The South Florida Water Management District is funding an edge-of-farm demonstration of PhosPhilter™, and field test results will be available soon.
