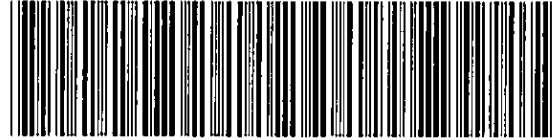

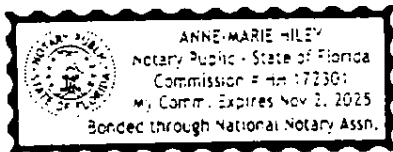

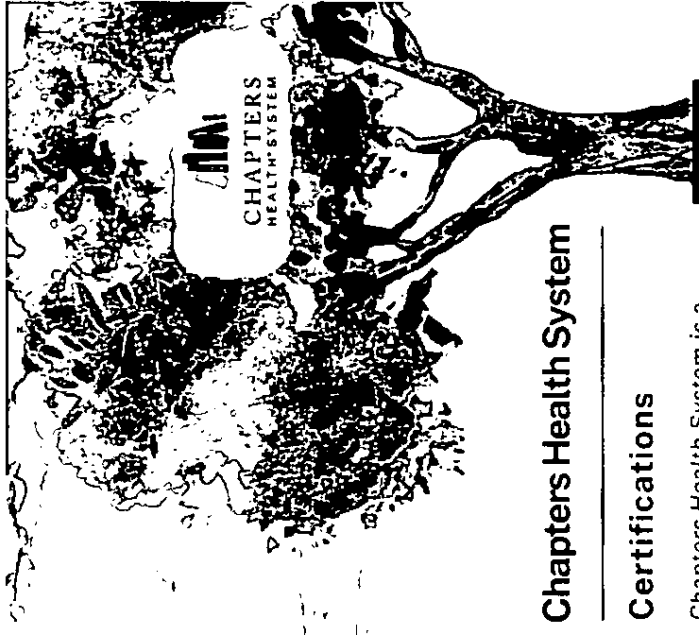

When we first came to the Bethany Center, my daughter was so grief-stricken about losing her father suddenly from a heart attack, she had completely withdrawn from life. Her close friends no longer mattered. She was even defiant toward her favorite teachers.

Special Grief Programs

- **Individual and Family Support** is available to hospice survivors and community members as they work through the grieving and healing process. Services are offered at no charge.
- **Support Groups** provide a safe place to express feelings, share experiences, learn about grief and move ahead in the healing process. Groups are open to all community members who have experienced the death of a love one and are free of charge.
- **Special Events** such as memorial services and holiday workshops, are offered at different locations each year.
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Children's Programs

- **The Bethany Center for Grieving Children** is a safe, loving place where children, teens and their families can share experiences as they move through the grieving and healing process. 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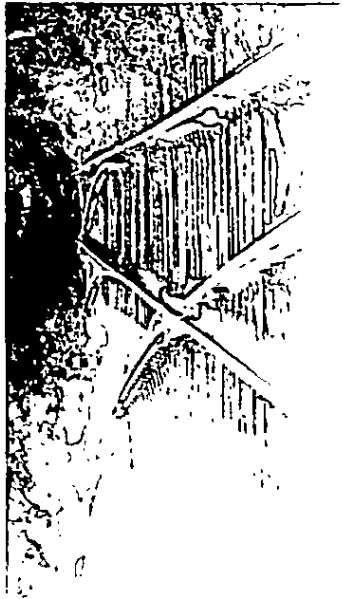

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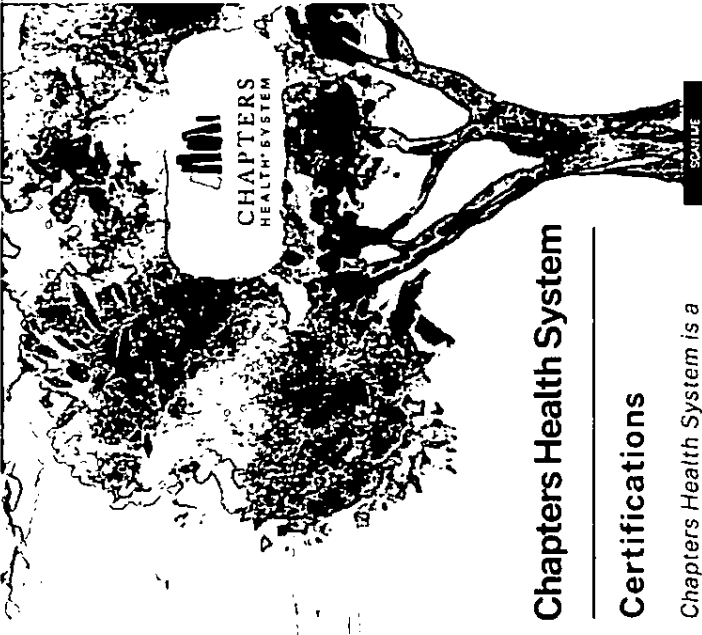
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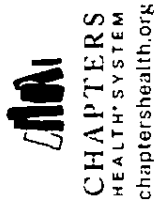
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
