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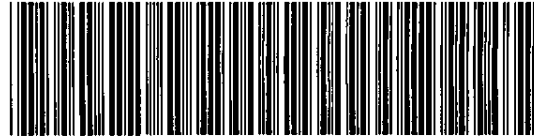

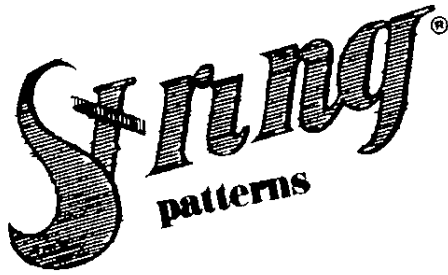

I am interested in submitting four book proposals for review and publication consideration. The book proposals are categorized as Curriculum and Arts and Crafts.

With a resurgence in the use of hands-on mathematics models for classroom instruction, it is time to update a proven success formula for teachers and students from grade 4 to adult.

My proposals motivate people to WANT to learn, not to fear learning; to decrease stress in the classroom; to demonstrate the practical use of concepts to make subjects interesting and exciting. 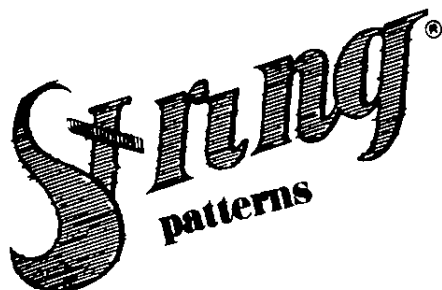

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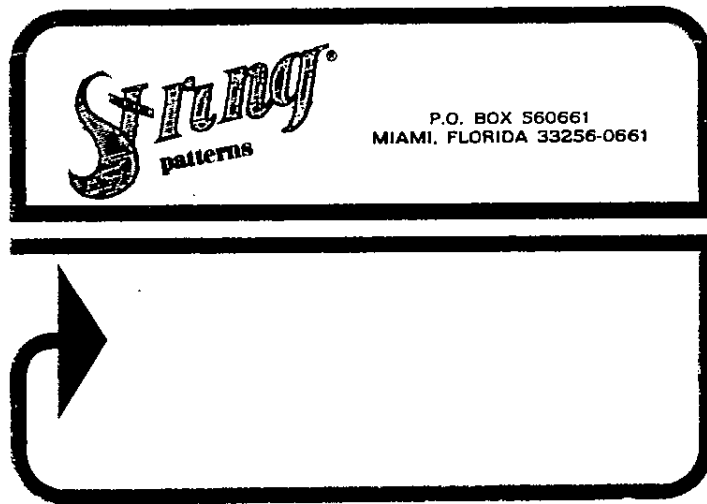

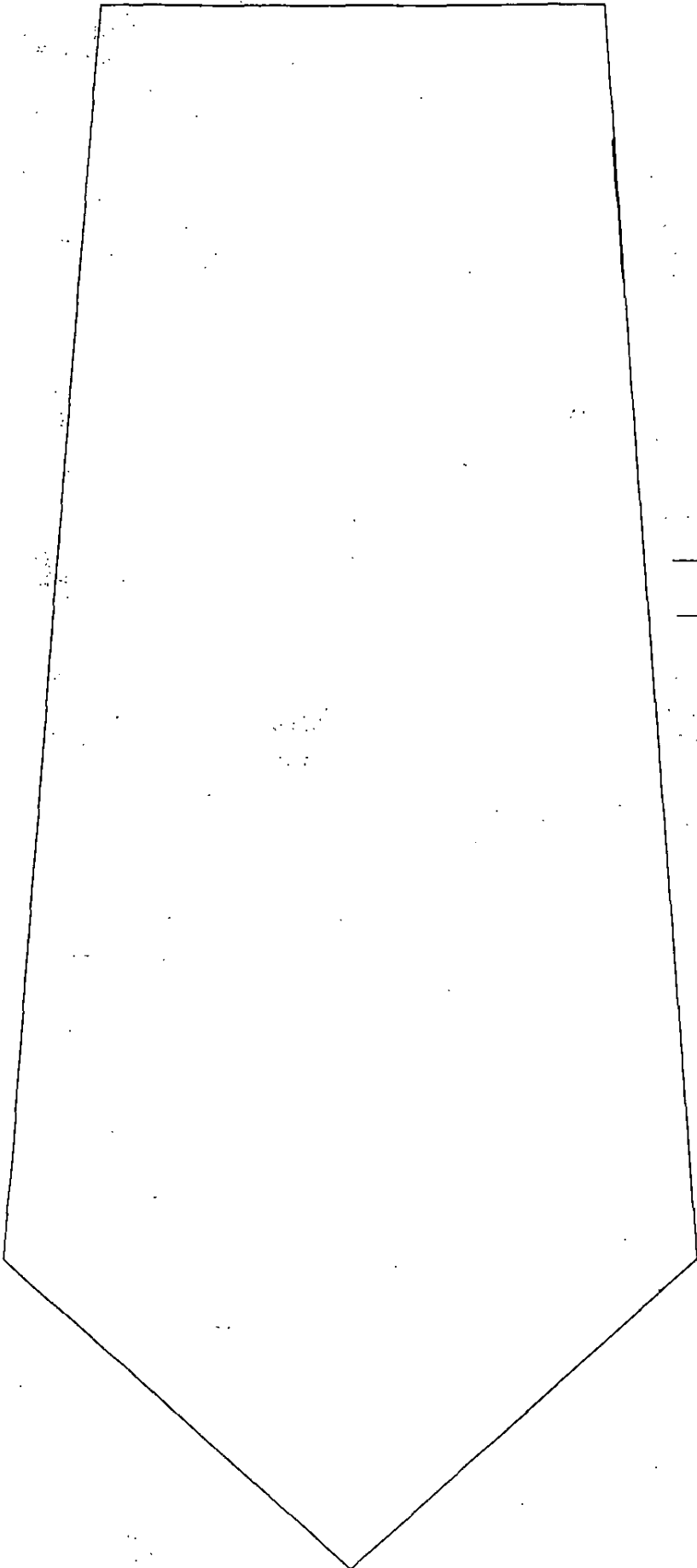
