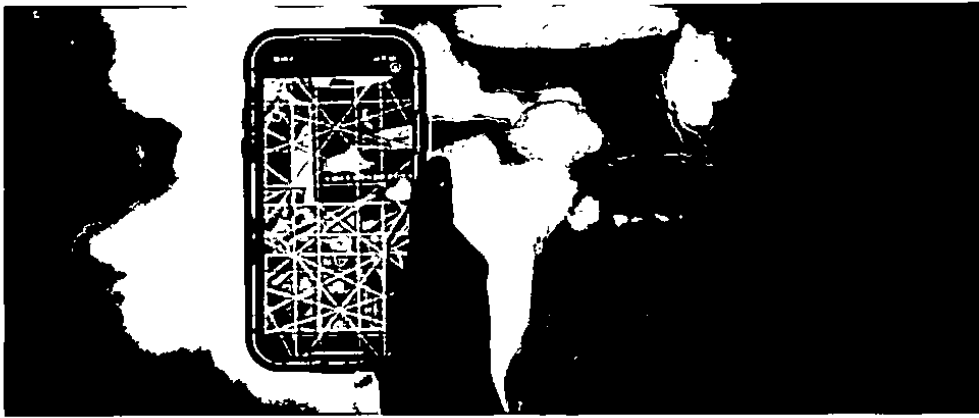

student programs at the dali

The Dalí Museum offers a variety of student programs inspired by Salvador Dalí, the Museum's permanent collection and special exhibitions.

The Dalí in the Classroom

Pinellas County teachers are invited to bring the culture and art of Salvador Dalí into the classroom virtually. Via Microsoft Teams or Zoom, a Museum's trained docent will guide the class through Dalí's key works, 6 other important topics.

Fashion Design

This free program shows high school students to learn the fundamentals of design, construction and runway presentation from experienced artists and designers.

Junior Docent Art Camp

Created in 1984, the Dalí Museum Junior Docent Program is a summer camp offered to children 9 to 12 years of age.

Teen Voices

This free semester-long program empowers high school students (grades 9-12) to become interpreters of the world and works of Salvador Dalí.

Student Surrealist Art Exhibit

Initiated in 1985, this annual student art exhibit invites middle- and high-school students to envision the world the way Dalí and the Surrealists did.

Summer Volunteer Program

This free summer program offers high school students (ages 14+) education and enrichment opportunities, introducing them to volunteerism and immersing them in the world of Salvador Dalí.
