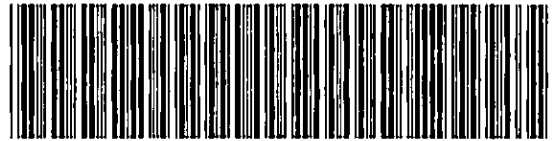

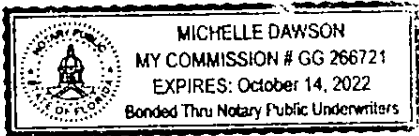

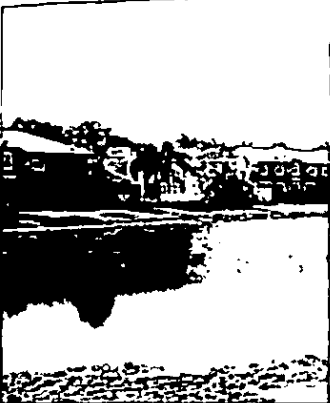

About Us

The Charles F.
