Pay Increases for Correctional Officers

The salary increases approved for Fiscal Year 2022/2023 affect both security and non-security positions to include a 5.38% increase for all full-time employees, new minimum salaries and retention bonuses for Correctional Officers, and a new minimum wage for state employees. Salary increases are effective July 1, 2022 and are included on the July 15, 2022 paycheck.



*Pay increases are available for additional ranks to encourage a lasting career with FDC!

1. Employees will have a 5.38% increase applied to their annual salary as of 06/30/2022.
2. Employees' annual salaries will be compared to the new minimum salary for their current position:

- If, after the 5.38% increase, an employee makes more than the new minimum salary for their current class, the employee will stay at that rate of pay.
- If, after the 5.38% increase, an employee makes less than the new minimum salary for their current class, the employee will be increased to the new minimum salary.

Correctional Officer Benefits Breakdown

When you begin a career as a Correctional Officer with the Florida Department of Corrections, you earn more than just a salary, the benefits stack up.



Retention Salary Increase

A retention salary increase will be applied to Correctional Officers' annual salaries based on continuous years of service in one or more of the security classes as of July 1, 2022:

- Two (2) years of service up to five (5) years of service: \$1,000 annually.
- Five (5) years of service up to eight (8) years of service: \$1,500 annually.
- Eight (8) or more years of service: \$2,500 annually.

Tuition Waiver Program


The State of Florida offers educational assistance to full-time, salaried employees by allowing each state university and state college to waive tuition and fees for up to six credit hours per semester on a space-available basis. The tuition waiver program may be used for up to 18 hours per calendar year.

The state university or state college determines whether your courses are eligible for the fee waiver. In addition, you must meet all the academic and admission requirements for the school and register during the special registration period the college sets aside for state employees. The program includes:

- Graduate or undergraduate programs. Check with the school to see if certain courses or programs are excluded.
- Related or unrelated to your work for the state.
- Held during or outside of your work hours. (Taking a course during your normal work hours requires supervisor approval and you must make up the time missed from work or use approved annual, compensatory leave or paid educational leave.)


