What's New On The Internet?

The newest feature on the Internet that is growing in leaps and bounds is called the World Wide Web. The Web, as it is commonly called, is a hypertext format with a graphic interface allowing one to connect and view pictures as well as text.

You might be asking. "how do I get on the Web?" Well, if you have a major online service like America Online, CompuServe, and/or Prodigy, they have just added this feature. If, however, you don't, your service might have only a text browser for the Web such as LINX. But that's okay. You may not see the graphics on the screen as you enter and browse through the website, but you can download with LINX. So, if there are images that you would like to browse at home, you can. For example, you can go to NASA and download images from the Hubble telescope or, more recently, images of the MIR (the Russian space station) and Space Shuttle connecting.

Now this may be wetting your appetite and you may be asking, "how do I find things on the Web". Well, as with all things on the Internet, you need an address. This address will transport you to other host computers around the world to the various sites you would like to go to. If I give you only one address, that would be enough to start explering the Web. However, it needs to be an address that has lots of links. Links are called URL's (Universal Resource Locators). They connect you to other locations on the Web. The first place to go to begin to find various places and

locations on the Web would be to start at YAHOO YAHOO is one of the best connected sites on the Web YAHOO lists new and old sites. It is constantly being updated. To get to YAHOO, you would use the address http. www.vahoo.com

Once there, you can do a search for the area you are looking for the is very easy and there are directions onscreen to help you

Another location on the Web for parents would be Uncle Bob's Home Page—Uncle Bob has put together a really great site with an incredible amount of URL's to places such as Michael Jordan's Home Page. The White House. Sea World, Dinosaurs in Hawaii, NASA, and Math Magic - to name a fraction of the well over 100 links there—The address for Uncle Bob's Home Page is http://gagme.wwa.com-boba.kids.html

In essence, the Web is another way to browse the Internet. Not all locations on the net have Web sites, but it is developing so rapidly that in no time at all, almost every location will have a Web page. It might be easier to view it as a huge spider's web, encircling the earth. As with a spider's web, there are many places where various lines connect (Web sites) and several lines of web leaving in different directions (URL's), each connecting at different areas. Are you starting to see that the possibilities are absolutely endless?


