### *Take the Community Survey on Public Art Project*

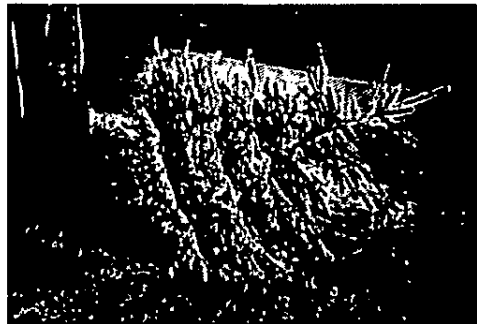

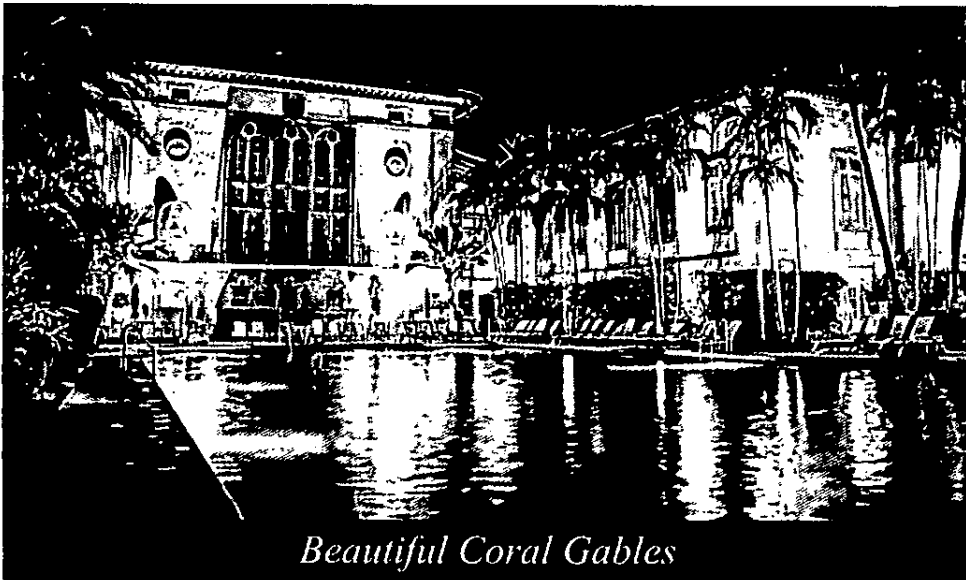


## Camp Kesem Miami Helps Children Deal with Parent's Cancer

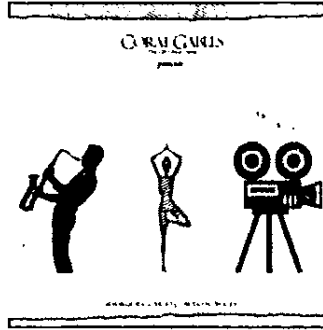

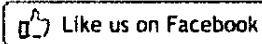
