



A Challenge to go Green

What does it mean for a building to be classified green? The answer can take many guises. For some buildings, it is to rely on solar power and other alternative energy sources; for others, avoiding PVC plastic and other harmful construction materials. It means developing buildings or renovating existing buildings to increase their efficiency and reduce their impact on the environment and human health.

Alhambra Towers was not built to be certified under the U.S. Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) program, a national standard for commercial buildings, but it supports many practices that conserve energy and resources. Lighting inside the elevators turn off when not in use, floor to ceiling windows draws daylight and minimizes energy use, and keeping a healthy amount of vegetation; trees and other green space in and around the property, cuts down on the amount of heat absorbed by concrete paving and reduces the solar heating of the building.

As we all want to save the planet and conserve resources, here are some ways that we can accomplish that in the office:



Use a power strip that can be turned off and on, as opposed to leaving the computer, printer, and monitor in 'sleep' modes. While in sleep mode, these machines are still drawing power. The current is minor, but when the savings is calculated over a year, the savings equates to \$39.60 per person. For Alhambra Towers this can be as high as \$24,000.

Plugging the cell phone charger into the power strip as well saves energy. The cell phone charger when not in use still consumes power. In fact, all transformers from the portable computer to the cordless phone at home consume power when not in use.

Set the thermostat for long periods of times. You use more energy if you consistently keep changing the setting.

Make sure all the lights and equipment are off in the office at the end of the work day, especially copier machines, that again, which in sleep mode still uses power.

Encourage the use of recycling paper bins. You can obtain these from the Management office.
