I have also been able to "speak" with many of you through e-mail and the internet, and it has been a special surprise and blessing to renew old friendships, some dating back to high school. Boy, is this internet thing great, or what? I am in touch with musicians around the world and am aware how much we all have in common. If you have not checked out my web site today, do so immediately! Even if you visited yesterday, you'll want to check again today because lupdate the site daily to change the performance schedule, articles, press releases, reviews, photos, recording and purchasing information and anything else I can think of. www.JoyfulNoise.net. E-mail to say hello, place an order, offer a comment, ask a question, or check out whether I'm really there. E-mail is a wonderful and easy way to keep in touch. And I'm very chatty.

My entire catalog of recordings now is available on CD and is stocked in a number of area stores, including my new release *Passages* and my entire catalog of Judaic recordings, *Seasons of Joy, The Heart of Ancient Promise*, and *How Good and How Pleasant*. Available on cassette or by special hand-made order on CD is *Soul Stream*, my album of music for meditation, and *Live at the Springs*, the beautiful live performance at the CD Release Party of music from the Judaic albums. All great gift ideas!

And as if that wasn't enough ... you may now obtain the **Joy T-Shirt** with the Joy Logo and web site address on the front and the Passages album cover in full color on the back. They are 100% cotton heavy-weight natural ivory T-shirts. What a great gift idea!

The summer and fall hold many activities. In July, I travel to North Carolina, performing at the Osceola Lake Inn in Hendersonville and at the Unity Church of Arden in Asheville. Then August 1st at 6 p.m., I have a special performance of music from the Judaic albums at Borders Books in St. Petersburg. The next day I join Mike Eisenstadt for his two-week tour of Israel. On September 4th, I am privileged to join Cantor Shimon Gewirtz at Congregation B'nai Israel's S'lichot Concert preceding the S'lichot service that evening at 9 p.m. Beginning September 17th, I take over as full-time Cantorial Soloist for Congregation Aliyah in Clearwater, completing my five-year work with Temple Shir Shalom in Gainesville and Congregation B'nai Emmunah in Tarpon Springs. I will sing for Temple Shir Shalom for High Holy Days, then begin the new year with Congregation Aliyah. It is with much sadness that I depart Shir Shalom and B'nai Emmunah. They are mispochah to me, and I hope to continue to join both congregations for special events. But I look forward to being closer to home and to many wonderful possibilities with Congregation Aliyah.

The fall months hold in store many wonderful concerts. Fellow writer-performer-recording artists Shana Smith & Bonnie Whitehurst & I have created In the Round & On the Road, a songwriters-in-the-round concert with

songs and stories of the three of us. Our first concerts are Borders Books/South Tampa, Aug. 22nd, Borders Books/St. Petersburg, Sept. 18th, Unity Church of Today in Tampa on October 3rd, and Borders Books/Carrollwood, Nov. 14th. Don't miss these pro-grams! We'll share our original music, the stories behind our songs, probably a good joke or two, and perform together as well as individually. They will be wonderful shows, and each will feature different music, so be sure to catch all of them. If you have been to or heard of Nashville's Bluebird Cafe, then you'll have an idea what we're creating here. It's a very intimate, funny, moving listening experience that you will love.

Several outstanding programs have been planned at Borders Bookstores throughout the area for the fall and winter months, including a **Day of Judaism** at Borders in Carrollwood from 1 to 9 p.m. on October 10th, at which I perform at 7 p.m., a **Day of Judaism** at Borders in St. Petersburg from 1 to 9 p.m. on November 14th, at which I perform at 5 p.m., and a **Chanukah Celebration** at Borders in South Tampa on December 5th, in which I'm joined by Rabbi Robert Schenkerman, D.D. at 4 p.m. These programs include book reviews, book readings, the showing of a children's cartoon sponsored by the Florida Gulf Coast Jewish Film Festival, hor d'ourves, and my own concerts, each day focusing on a different theme. More are already scheduled for January, March, and April 2000 as well. Details are included on the back of this sheet.

On August 29th, I will give my audio lecture/demonstration program *Sound Health: Relieving Stress Through Music* at 1:30 p.m. at the Unity Church of Today in Tampa. This is an outstanding program featuring audio excerpts and the presentation of scientific evidence of the effect of sound on the physical and emotional body, with a practical guide for empowering one's life through the most beneficial uses of music. On November 21st, singer-songwriter Jeanie Fitchen and I will give a special house concert at my home as part of the **Women Musicians Alliance's Shifting Sands Concert Series**. A pot-luck dinner at 5 p.m. will be followed by the concert of original music and stories behind the songs at 6:00. Call me for information.

I continue as Music Director of the **Unity Church of Today** at 8210 W. Waters Avenue in Tampa, a non-denominational congregation of fellowship, meditation, and prayer consciousness, where percussionist Tim Diehl and I provide music each Sunday morning for the 11 a.m. service and present special programs during the year. They are a wonderful spiritual family and I have the pleasure to put together a beautiful combination of music for each service that includes my own compositions as well as meaningful songs from virtually every category of music. Tim and I begin at 10:50 a.m.

I continue to work with the Florida Artist Residency Program (funded by the Department of State), which places artists in schools throughout Florida. Other artists and I share our music and stories with children of all ages in my program, Of Musical Note. These performances are a delight — really fun for the kids and us — and are extremely affordable or even available to some schools by grant. Call me for information. Free copies of the Florida Artist Residency Directory, in which I and about 90 other Department of State-sponsored artists are listed, are free upon request from any County Arts Council or the Department of State in Tallahassee.
