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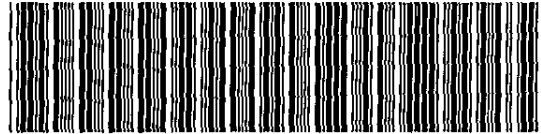



Pursuant to Fla. Stat. §607.1403, this corporation submits the following articles of dissolution:


1. The name of the corporation is **DEO VOLENTE & DELACROIX, INC.**
