STIPULATED FINAL JUDGMENT DISSOLVING ASSOCIATED PUBLIC ADJUSTERS, INC.

Upon the stipulation of the parties and the only other shareholder, director and officer of the Defendant as shown by their signatures at the end of this Judgment, it is,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

The Defendant corporation, Associated Public Adjusters, Inc. is hereby dissolved with an effective date of the dissolution being the date of this judgment. The Clerk of the Court shall deliver a certified copy of this judgment to the Department of State, pursuant to Florida Statute 607.1433(1),(1997). It is, further,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

James Speed is appointed as receiver of all property owned by Associated Public Adjusters, Inc., and is directed to wind up and liquidate the business and affairs of the corporation pursuant to § 607, Florida Statutes.

Because the parties were not able to agree upon a specific list of powers of the receiver, such specific list of powers shall be set forth by subsequent order of this court, if the court determines it appropriate to issue such order. Otherwise, the receiver shall have and is hereby given all of the usual, necessary and incidental powers of receivers for the purpose of winding up and liquidating the business and affairs of the corporation. The parties shall have the right to petition to the Court for an Order expanding, decreasing, or changing the powers of the receiver during the term of the receivership. Further, the receiver shall be at liberty to apply to this court at any time during the pendency of this cause for further direction.
