Dear Division of Corporations:

I called your office today, and spoke with "Stacey". I explained our situation regarding having just received our notice from your office and our failure to pay the annual corporate dues for 1997 by May 1, 1997. She suggested I write this letter and explain what happened, including a payment of \$ 165.00, which is the normal fee.

Late last year I sold the main operations (service contracts) of our corporation to an individual, but retained the corporation. During the year end and the first of January, we had trouble with the post office. We instructed the post office to forward all mail pertaining to those particular contracts to the individual that purchased those contracts, but to continue sending all mail through to us for corporate matters. We found several times where the post office forwarded mail and parcels to her in error, and wondered how many other items were lost that were never knew about. We have looked into our files completely, and my wife is very good about her record keeping. We are absolutely sure that we never received our renewal notice from your office.

We have always paid our corporate fee timely in the past. I realize that, ultimately it is our responsibility to pay this fee with or without a form. However, I apologize for this oversight, and would have certainly paid the fee and filed the report if we would have received it. I request that this one time our penalties be abated, that you receive the enclosed renewal fee and form, and reinstate our corporation. Our operations for the past eight months have been minimal, and the penalties due would create a hardship for us at this time, to the extent that we may not be able to pay them. I do not want to dissolve this corporation, and I deeply appreciate your cooperation with our request.
