Dear Sir or Madam:

We received your letter dated October 21, 2002 regarding the above-mentioned corporation. We would like to ask that you consider the following information before charging a reinstatement fee.

The taxpayer filled out the annual report, and included a check and mailed prior to May 1. The check was written with the written amount for \$150. A check's legal written amount is for the amount in writing, not in numbers. The numbers are only referenced if the writing is not legible. Your office returned the check with a letter dated June 4, 2002, which the client received on October 8, 2002. The corporate officer followed the directions on the letter, and wrote the numbers on the check and then returned it to your office.

The officer has now received this letter, which is asking that the payee be corrected. As a CPA, I see many checks written by clients to a payee other than the Department of State. I have never seen any of those clients with this type of problem. Further, the Department of State is asking for reinstatement fees. We don't feel that the corporation should be charged reinstatement fees based upon the fact that the check would have went through back in April when it was originally mailed. Further, the corporation did not receive the letter dated June 4 until October 8. We don't feel that it's fair to penalize the corporation. The corporate officer returned the check and annual report within 30 days of receipt of the letter.

Based upon the above information, we are requesting that the Department of State consider reversing the reinstatement fees for the corporation.
