We are the accountants for this corporation and have the responsibility of preparing this report for timely filing. I have the responsibility to see that work is done timely and correctly.


At the end of October 1999 I had open-heart surgery and as such missed much office time. It has only been in the last month to six weeks that I have been able to maintain a more regular schedule.
