ORDER APPOINTING RECEIVER

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard on June 4, 1996 upon the parties' stipulation and the ratified Partial Settlement Agreement dated May 31, 1996 and the Court being fully advised in the premises; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Appointment: Michael A. Fischler, Esquire, of Fischler & Friedman, P.A. be and the same is hereby appointed Receiver of Apple A Day Natural Foods, Inc. and Premier Products, Inc. (the "Businesses") and all of their assets, wherever located, their principal place of business being 1534 Alton Road and 1407 Alton Road, Miami Beach, Dade County, Florida, a townhome, 2734 N.W. 199

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Terrace, Miami, Florida, and a six-unit apartment building, 92 N.E. 65th Street, Miami, Florida (the "Properties").

2. Receiver Entry on to Premises: The Receiver is hereby authorized and empowered to enter the principal place of business and any other location where assets of the businesses are located; to operate, manage, and maintain the property; to demand, collect, and receive all rents, revenues, issues, and profits from the businesses' operation; and to perform all necessary actions to operate the businesses or properties as a receiver until liquidated or sold, as the receiver deems appropriate.

3. Possession of Corporate Property: The Receiver shall take possession of all the assets, files, papers, records, documents, monies, securities, choses in action, books of account, and all other property, real, personal, or mixed, of the businesses or property which are within the jurisdiction of this Court, and shall retain custody of all such property, records, and documents until further Order of this Court. All persons or corporations now or hereafter in possession of any part of the property are directed to forthwith surrender possession thereof to the Receiver, and such other persons or corporations as may lawfully be in possession thereof are directed to attorn as tenant(s) to said Receiver and to pay over to the Receiver all rents for such Property now due and unpaid or that hereinafter become due until further Order of this Court. All persons in possession of the books and records relating to the businesses, including but not limited to, leases, books of account, insurance

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policies, insurance certificates, income records, maintenance contracts, utility records, and any and all correspondence and documentation relating thereto shall surrender possession to the Receiver. The Receiver shall take possession of the premises and all books and records thereof. The Receiver is hereby authorized to employ agents, servants, employees, and professionals and to contract as necessary for the purpose of taking possession of the businesses or property and managing and/or liquidating or selling the businesses or property.

4. No Interference: During the pendency of this action, all of the parties, their successors and assigns and all persons or corporations having a claim by, through, under or against said Defendants, their agents and attorneys be and the same are hereby enjoined and restrained from collecting, or attempting to collect, the profits or issues derived from the businesses or properties and from interfering in any manner with the management of the businesses or properties, or their possession or operation by the Receiver; however, to the extent requested by receiver, the parties shall provide cooperation.

5. Receiver's Powers: The Receiver hereby appointed shall have and is hereby given all powers necessary to accomplish the foregoing, and the usual, necessary, and incidental powers of a Receiver for the purposes of managing, securing, and maintaining the businesses and properties, including the power to make such repairs to the Premises, and to hire such employees and professionals, including accountants and attorneys, as in the

Receiver's judgment are necessary to operate, maintain and secure the businesses and properties. The Receiver or any party hereto, on notice to all parties who have appeared in this action, may apply at any time to this Court for further and other instructions, and for further power necessary to enable the Receiver to properly fulfill his duties.

6. Specific Duties of Receiver: The Receiver shall do such acts necessary and prudent to maintain the principal business operations of the businesses until sale or liquidation.

7. Operating Account: Upon entry of this Order, the Receiver may establish and maintain, at a bank whose deposits are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, a separate operating account(s) (the "Operating Account") into which the Receiver shall deposit the receipts from the businesses, and from which the Receiver shall make disbursements from the Operating Account as follows:

(i) Ordinary and necessary operating expenses, including but not limited to utilities, insurance premiums, salaries, payroll, and routine repair and maintenance expenses, including such vendor contracts and equipment leases that the Receiver determines to be commercially reasonable, arms-length transactions.

(ii) The reasonable costs and expenses of repairs.

(iii) Payment of taxes.

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8. Records: The Receiver will maintain records, books, and accounts concerning the operation of the businesses and/or properties. Upon reasonable notice, and at all reasonable times, the parties and their respective agents and other representatives shall have reasonable access to such records, accounts and books and to all vouchers, files and all other materials pertaining to the operation of the businesses and/or properties.


9. Receiver's Fees: The Receiver shall be entitled to payment of fees for his services at the rate of \$175.00 per hour.

10. Counsel: The Receiver is hereby empowered, subject to prior Court approval, to employ independent legal counsel to furnish legal advice to the Custodian for such purposes as may be necessary during the period of receivership.

11. Accountant: The Receiver is hereby empowered to employ independent accountants to furnish accounting services to the Receiver for such purposes as may be necessary during the period of the receivership.
